TV's and Tunes

<u>TV's</u> – One upper floor and one lower floor games room.

<u>Upper floor</u> has one controller and only one feed, Apple TV. Turn on power and make sure the source selection is HMDI 1. We have left our Netflix, Crave, and Amazon accounts open on the system for you to enjoy. If you want to log in with your Apple ID you may do that so you can watch/purchase your own TV or Movies.

<u>Lower floor</u> has one controller and two feeds, Apple TV and PS4. Turn on power and choose either HMDI1 for Apple TV or HDMI 2 for PS4. We have left a guest account open for PS4 to use or you may choose to use your own log in/account. Same for Apple TV, we have left our Netflix, Crave, and Amazon accounts open. If you want to log in with your Apple ID you may do that in order to watch/purchase your own TV or Movies

Please remember to log out of your own Apple ID and PS4 accounts before you leave!



Tunes

In the hutch in the dining room are two UE Boom wireless speakers, one large and one small. Both are rechargeable and each case has charging cables/wall plugs.

- Turn on your Bluetooth on your phone so that it is searching for a device
- 2) Turn on/press the power button on the side of either UE Boom, it will make a drum sound, then press the small button until both power and small button are flashing
- 3) Look at your phone's Bluetooth screen and you should see either UE Megaboom or UE Boom 2
- 4) Select whichever unit you are wanting to use and once connected the UE Booms will make a drum sound and then show connected on your Bluetooth screen
- 5) Choose/play your own tunes and enjoy!

When finished using please loosen the U nut on the bottom end of either unit, twist the flap to expose the input for charge cable and plug in overnight.

NOTE: the units can be taken outside and are waterproof but please do not leave them outside overnight or in the rain.



BBQ

THE GAS FEED IS ON A TIMER!

Remove the BBQ cover, fold up, and place somewhere dry under the pergola.

Look behind the BBQ and you will see a round dial, turn that dial to whatever you wish, one hour-three hours, and then that will start the flow of natural gas.

WARNING: DO NOT LEAVE THIS BBQ ON HIGH...MAX LOW TO MED, AS THIS IS A VERY HOT BBQ!

There are 3 burner dials from left to right, press each one in and turn, and hold to create spark and ignite each burner. 4th dial on the far right is for the back burner/rotisserie.

You will need to plug in the rotisserie unit to make the light work. Electrical cord in the bottom of the BBQ.

Rotisserie bar and clasps are in the main hall closet. If you use the rotisserie you MUST place a baking pan under whatever you are cooking to catch fat/grease.

When finished using BBQ please clean thoroughly using scraper provided and when cooled down put the cover back on...please and thanks.



Furnace/Heat and Gas Fireplace(s)

Furnace can be controlled by adjusting NEST unit against wall in main hallway. If you put your hand near it the display will appear, or you just push on it. You can turn the temp up or down by rotating the dial.

If you use the fireplace on the main floor it heats up that entire floor pretty fast and will show 20-21 degrees C on the Nest unit. Point being is you don't need both on when hanging out on the main floor.

When you shut down the fireplace and go to bed you need to ensure that the Nest is set at 18 degrees. Very efficient new furnace and anything above 22 degrees C setting will get pretty warm throughout main and upper floors.

Gas fireplace on main floor is controlled by a timer on the wall that you can set for 30-60-120 minutes.

Gas fireplace on lower floor is controlled by remote on right side of fireplace wall. Press/hold flame up button, (they look like volume controls), to start and/or increase flame, and flame down to shut off and/or reduce flame.

Lower floor has two electrical baseboard heaters that are controlled by a large white digital pad on the wall closest to the stairs with 4 light switches. Touch the pad and you can raise or lower the temp.



Laundry/Vacuum/Supplies/Iron & Ironing Board

<u>Washer and Dryer</u> are pretty straight forward. Manuals are in a drawer to the right of the fridge.

Please <u>do not overload the washer</u> as it will create an imbalanced load during spin cycle and then when trying to spin will just stop/start over and over until you reset the load.

Try to use normal settings for either, washer soap is in main closet in hallway on right, either pods or powder as well Bounce.

NOTE: when you leave please strip the beds and leave sheets/linens in laundry baskets for housekeeper, thx.

<u>Vacuum</u> is attached to left side wall in the same are/closet as washer/dryer. It is rechargeable so when finished using please place back in charger. Additional tools/attachments are in main hallway closet on right.

<u>Mop/Cleaning Supplies</u> – Spin Mop/Bucket are in same area as vacuum. All additional cleaning supplies are in main hallway closet on the right.

<u>Iron/Ironing Board</u> – Iron & Ironing board (mini) is in main hallway closet on right.

So best to stock up closer to Nanaimo at the massive big box and retail store zone that is about 15-20 minutes from the house and you will find everything and anything you need in and around this area.


Everything is off of Aulds Rd. You can Google "Save On Foods 6901 N Island Hwy, Nanaimo, BC" to find a centre point of all stores.

Garbage & Recycling

Please put out Garbage & Recycling out on the road the night before pickup





When You Leave

- 1) Please strip all beds, linens, pillow cases, and towels and place in baskets near washer/dryer.
- 2) Make sure you have turned all lights off, any appliances, and fireplaces.
- 3) Please close all windows
- 4) Ensure that all garbage is bagged, as well recycling, and placed into the garbage cans and into recycling bins in the carport.
- 5) Clean BBQ and place cover back on
- 6) Make sure umbrella is tied down
- 7) Make sure all sliding doors and French doors are shut and locked including the lower floor. Pleas lock front door when you leave and put key back into lock box.
